FOR the purpose of prohibiting a motor carrier person from falsifying, duplicating, or 4 5 attempting to falsify or duplicate certain knowingly falsifying or using, holding, 6 possessing, giving away, or selling certain falsified licenses, decals, or other 7 official documents issued by the Comptroller; prohibiting a motor carrier person 8 from manufacturing, constructing, or possessing certain paraphernalia; 9 prohibiting a motor carrier from possessing, giving away, selling, or attempting to sell certain items; prohibiting a motor carrier from holding or using 10 attempting to falsify or sell certain licenses or decals that have been falsified or 11 duplicated in violation of this Act; specifying certain penalties for certain 12 13 violations of this Act; defining certain terms; defining "falsify" for purposes of this Act to include alter, counterfeit, duplicate, manufacture, construct, or forge; 14 and generally relating to the falsification or duplication of certain licenses. 15decals, or other official documents issued by the Comptroller. 16
