A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Motor Fuel Taxes - Biodiesel Fuel User License

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a person to be licensed by the Comptroller before the 4 person may buy, produce, acquire, receive, or store certain biodiesel fuel on 5 which the motor fuel tax has not been paid and use it in certain motor vehicles; 6 providing for the issuance of a biodiesel fuel user license under the motor fuel 7 tax law; requiring applicants for a biodiesel fuel user license to post security in 8 a certain minimum amount except under certain circumstances; defining 9 certain terms and altering certain definitions under the motor fuel tax law; and generally relating to use of biodiesel fuel and the motor fuel tax. 10

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 "BIODIESEL FUEL" MEANS ANY FUEL OR MIXTURE OF FUEL THAT (C-1) $\mathbf{2}$ IS DERIVED IN WHOLE OR IN PART FROM AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS OR ANIMAL 3 FATS OR THE WASTES OF SUCH PRODUCTS. "Special fuel" means a product that is usable as fuel in an internal 4 (h) (1)combustion engine. 5 6 "Special fuel" includes: (2)7 **(I)** clean-burning fuel except electricity; AND 8 **(II) BIODIESEL FUEL.** 9 (3)"Special fuel" does not include gasoline. 9-301. 10 (D-1) "ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF A BIODIESEL FUEL USER" MEANS 11 12 TO: 13(1) BUY, PRODUCE, ACQUIRE, RECEIVE, OR STORE BIODIESEL 14FUEL ON WHICH THE MOTOR FUEL TAX HAS NOT BEEN PAID; AND 15**(2) USE IT IN A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS:** 16 **(I)** OWNED OR OPERATED BY THE BIODIESEL FUEL USER; 17AND 18 **(II) REGISTERED TO OPERATE ON A PUBLIC HIGHWAY.** 19 (1) "Engage in the business of a special fuel user" means to: (h) 20[(1)] **(I)** buy special fuel on which the motor fuel tax has not been 21paid; and 22[(2)]**(II)** use it in a motor vehicle that is: 23[(i)]1. owned or operated by the special fuel user; and 24[(ii)] **2.** registered to operate on a public highway. 25**(2)** "ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF A SPECIAL FUEL USER" 26INCLUDES TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF A BIODIESEL FUEL USER.

2 (H-1) A CLASS "U-1" LICENSE AUTHORIZES A LICENSEE TO ENGAGE, IN 3 THIS STATE, IN THE BUSINESS OF A BIODIESEL FUEL USER.

5 (f) The Comptroller shall require an applicant for any license under Title 9 6 of this article, except for a Class "W" license, to post security for the motor fuel tax in 7 the amount that the Comptroller requires, but not less than:

- (8) **(I)** \$1,000 for a Class "U" license; AND

9 (II) \$1,000 FOR A CLASS "U-1" LICENSE, PROVIDED THAT 10 SECURITY IS NOT REQUIRED IF THE BIODIESEL FUEL USER HAS PRODUCED, 11 ACQUIRED, RECEIVED, OR STORED LESS THAN 4,000 GALLONS OF SPECIAL FUEL 12 TO BE USED IN A MOTOR VEHICLE DURING A CALENDAR YEAR.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2009.
