A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning 1

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Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages Act of 2009

3 FOR the purpose of altering certain alcoholic beverages license fees in Anne Arundel 4 County; establishing certain hotel-limited service licenses in the county; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the hotel-limited service licenses to certain persons; providing for the privileges and annual fees for the hotel-limited service licenses; requiring the Board to obtain criminal records of alcoholic beverages license applicants from certain governmental units, require applicants for licenses to be fingerprinted, and forward the 10 fingerprints to certain governmental units; establishing a certain nonrefundable 11 license renewal fee; authorizing the Board to issue a special outdoor license and a special outdoor entertainment license to holders of certain licenses; providing 12 for the privileges, annual fees, and renewal requirement for special outdoor 13 14 licenses and special outdoor entertainment licenses; authorizing the Board to 15 employ a part-time deputy chief inspector at a certain annual salary; altering 16 the number of part-time inspectors that the Board may employ; altering the annual salary of the attorney for the Board; altering the penalty the Board may impose for a violation that is cause for suspension of a license; making certain 18 19 stylistic changes; defining a certain term; and generally relating to alcoholic 20 beverages in Anne Arundel County.

A Class A light wine license may be issued only in:

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1 IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY (b) **(7)** THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THIS $\mathbf{2}$ LICENSE IS \$60. 3 5-101.A Class A beer and light wine license shall be issued by the license 4 (a) 5 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. The holder of 6 the license may keep for sale and sell beer and light wines at retail, in any quantity to any consumers, at the place described in the license. The holder shall deliver the beer 7 8 and light wines in a sealed package or container, which package or container may not 9 be opened nor its contents consumed on the premises where sold. 10 In Anne Arundel County the annual license fee is [\$200] **\$240**. (c) **(1)** 5-201.11 12(c) (1) This subsection applies only in Anne Arundel County. The annual license fee for a Class B beer and light wine license is 13 (2)14 [\$400] **\$480**. 15 I(3)There is a Class B–LSH (limited service hotel) beer and light 16 wine license for use in a hotel that contains more than 100 rooms and operates a 17 kitchen licensed as a food service facility. The annual license fee is \$2,000. 18 (ii) A Class B-LSH license authorizes the licensee to sell beer 19 and light wine in containers to registered guests, who may consume the beverage in 2021 their hotel rooms or remove unopened containers from the hotel premises. 22 5-202.23(b) A Class H beer and light wine license shall be issued by the license 24 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. The license 25 authorizes the holder to keep for sale and sell beer and light wines at retail at any hotel or restaurant, at the place described in the license, for consumption on the 26 27 premises. 28(d) In Anne Arundel County the annual license fee is [\$300] **\$360**. 5-301. 29


(a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (n) of this section, a Class C beer and light wine license shall be issued by the license issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. The holder of the license may keep for sale and

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consumption on the premises only.




