CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County and City of Annapolis – Alcoholic Beverages – Hours of**
3 **Sale – Inauguration Day**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that in Anne Arundel County or the City of Annapolis, a
5 certain establishment licensed for alcoholic beverages with an on–sale privilege
6 that is open on Inauguration Day may remain open for a certain period past its
7 normal closing time for on–premises consumption only on payment of a certain
8 fee; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to alcoholic
9 beverages licenses in Anne Arundel County and the City of Annapolis.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That in Anne Arundel County or the City of Annapolis, an
12 establishment that is licensed for alcoholic beverages with an on–sale privilege and
13 that is open on January 20, 2009, may remain open for up to 1 hour past its normal
14 closing time for consumption on the premises only, if the license holder pays a fee of
15 \$200 to the Anne Arundel County Board of License Commissioners or the City of
16 Annapolis Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, as appropriate.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
18 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
19 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members
20 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
21 the date it is enacted.
