Vehicle Laws - Transporting Pets in Trucks or Trailers

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from transporting certain animals in or on a truck or trailer on a highway unless the truck or trailer is enclosed in a certain manner or unless the pet is confined in a certain manner; providing that a violation of this Act is not a moving violation for certain purposes; defining a certain term; establishing that certain penalties apply to a violation of this Act; and generally relating to the transportation of pets in or on trucks or trailers.

- 3 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT TRANSPORT A PET IN OR ON A TRUCK OR 4 TRAILER ON A HIGHWAY UNLESS:
- 5 (1) THE TRUCK OR TRAILER IS ENCLOSED ON THE SIDES AND ON 6 THE TOP IN A MANNER THAT SAFELY PREVENTS THE PET FROM FALLING, 7 JUMPING, OR OTHERWISE EXITING THE TRUCK OR TRAILER; OR
- 8 (2) THE PET IS CONFINED BY A CONTAINER, CAGE, HARNESS, OR 9 OTHER DEVICE DESIGNED TO SAFELY PREVENT THE PET FROM FALLING, 10 JUMPING, OR OTHERWISE EXITING THE TRUCK OR TRAILER.
- 11 (C) A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS NOT A MOVING VIOLATION FOR 12 PURPOSES OF § 16–402 OF THIS ARTICLE.

- 14 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a 15 misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is 16 subject to a fine of not more than \$500.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
