4 FOR the purpose of exempting the renovation of certain historic structures by the
5 Department of General Services from certain provisions of the State
6 procurement law.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

20 11–203.

1 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this Division II does
2 not apply to:

3 (1) procurement by:

4 (xvi) the Maryland Energy Administration, when negotiating or
5 entering into grants or cooperative agreements with private entities to meet federal
6 specifications or solicitation requirements related to energy conservation, energy
7 efficiency, or renewable energy projects that benefit the State; [and]

8 (xvii) the Maryland Developmental Disabilities Administration of
9 the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene for family and individual support
10 services, and individual family care services, as those terms are defined by the
11 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene in regulation; AND

12 (XVIII) THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR
13 THE RENOVATION OF A STRUCTURE THAT:

14 1. WAS BUILT DURING THE 18TH OR 19TH CENTURY;
15 AND

16 2. IS LISTED IN OR ELIGIBLE FOR LISTING IN THE
17 NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES;

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 July 1, 2009.
