1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Facilities – Released Inmates – Identification Cards**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Commissioner of Correction to issue an
4 identification card that meets certain requirements to an inmate before release
5 from a certain State correctional facility; requiring the Commissioner of
6 Correction to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to identification
7 cards for released inmates.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Correctional Services**

2 (a) Whenever a date of release from confinement in a State correctional
3 facility is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the inmate shall be released on the
4 first preceding day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.

5 (b) The Commissioner **OF CORRECTION** shall adopt regulations:

6 (1) establishing a release plan for inmates upon release from
7 confinement in a State correctional facility to help identify resources to assist inmates
8 following release, including the provision of transportation from the facility for an
9 inmate upon release; **AND**

10 (2) **IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF § 9-609.1 OF THIS**
11 **SUBTITLE CONCERNING ISSUANCE OF AN IDENTIFICATION CARD TO INMATES**
12 **ON RELEASE FROM CONFINEMENT IN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.**

13 **9-609.1.**

14 (A) **THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION SHALL ISSUE AN**
15 **IDENTIFICATION CARD TO AN INMATE BEFORE RELEASE FROM CONFINEMENT**
16 **IN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.**

17 (B) **THE IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF**
18 **THIS SECTION SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SECONDARY**
19 **IDENTIFICATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AN IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY**
20 **THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION UNDER § 12-301 OF THE**
21 **TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2009.
