# A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

# State or Local Retirement or Pension System - Transfer of Service Credit Ordinary Disability Retirees

# FOR the purpose of exempting from certain benefit calculations certain individuals who retire from the State Retirement and Pension System with a certain retirement allowance within 5 years of transferring into one of the several systems of the State Retirement and Pension System; and generally relating to the transfer of service credit for ordinary disability retirees of the State Retirement and Pension System.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

18 37–203.

19 (f) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, after an individual 20 transfers service credit to a new system under this title, the individual:

(i) shall pay the rate of contribution applicable to a member of
 the new system; and

(ii) is eligible for a pension and annuity as provided under the
new system, determined by taking into account the transferred service credit.

1 (2) Except as provided in § 37–204 of this subtitle, if an individual 2 transfers from a noncontributory system to a contributory system, on retirement the 3 individual's retirement allowance shall be reduced by the actuarial equivalent of the 4 member contributions that would have been deducted if the individual had earned the 5 transferred service credit under the new system, including regular interest on those 6 contributions.

7 (3) (I) 1. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ITEM 2 OF THIS 8 SUBPARAGRAPH, THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO 9 RETIRES WITH AN ORDINARY DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 10 29–105 OF THIS ARTICLE WITHIN 5 YEARS AFTER TRANSFERRING INTO A NEW 11 SYSTEM.

12 2. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO RETIRES WITH AN ORDINARY
 13 DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 29–105 OF THIS ARTICLE
 14 WITHIN 5 YEARS AFTER TRANSFERRING INTO A NEW SYSTEM IS SUBJECT TO THE
 15 PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH IF THE BASIS OF THE ORDINARY DISABILITY
 16 RETIREMENT IS DETERMINED TO BE A PREEXISTING CONDITION THAT EXISTED
 17 BEFORE TRANSFERRING INTO THE NEW SYSTEM.

(II) If an individual retires within 5 years after transferring into
 a new system, the benefits payable with respect to the transferred service credit may
 not be greater than the benefits that would have been payable by the previous system
 with respect to that service if the individual had remained in the previous system.
