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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2008 - Montgomery County -**  
3 **Sharp Street United Methodist Church Modular Building**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2008  
5 to alter the location and matching fund requirements of a certain grant to the  
6 Board of Trustees of the Sharp Street United Methodist Church, Inc.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Chapter 336 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2008  
9 Section 1(3) Item (ZA01) (BP) and (ZA02) (BA)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 12 **Chapter 336 of the Acts of 2008**

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That:

15 (3) (ZA01) LOCAL SENATE INITIATIVES

16 (BP) Sharp Street United Methodist Church Modular Building.  
17 Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i) \$50,000 or (ii) the  
18 amount of the matching fund provided, to the Board of  
19 Trustees of the Sharp Street United Methodist Church, Inc.  
20 for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, and capital  
21 equipping of a modular building for use as a food pantry,  
22 located in [Silver] SANDY Spring, subject to a requirement  
23 that the grantee grant and convey a historic easement to the  
24 Maryland Historical Trust. Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of  
25 this Act, the matching fund may consist of **REAL PROPERTY**
