3 FOR the purpose of providing certain benefits to ~~elected~~ certain members of the

5 providing that the benefits established under this Act may not be considered  
6 compensation for certain purposes; and generally relating to the Dorchester  
7 County Board of Education.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 15 **Article – Education**

16 3–5A–04.

17 (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, the voting members shall receive  
18 compensation as set by the County Council.

19 (b) (1) The salary of each voting member of the county board shall be at  
20 least \$3,200.

6 SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS EXTENDED TO OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE  
7 COUNTY BOARD.

8 (2) A BOARD MEMBER'S PARTICIPATION IN A BENEFITS PROGRAM  
9 SPONSORED BY THE COUNTY BOARD UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS  
10 SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED COMPENSATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF  
11 CALCULATING COMPENSATION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
13 October 1, 2009.
