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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Homestead Property Tax Credit – Applications – Use of Social Security**  
3 **Numbers**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the State Department of Assessments and Taxation  
5 from requiring homeowner Social Security numbers on applications for  
6 qualification for the homestead property tax credit; and generally relating to  
7 homestead property tax credits.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Tax – Property**

21 9–105.

22 (d) (6) (i) To qualify for the credit under this section, a homeowner  
23 shall submit an application for the credit to the Department as provided in this  
24 paragraph.

- 1 (ii) 1. The application shall:  
2 [1.] A. be made on the form that the Department  
3 provides;  
4 [2.] B. provide the information required by the form;  
5 and  
6 [3.] C. include a statement by the homeowner under  
7 oath that the facts stated in the application are true, correct, and complete.

8 **2. THE APPLICATION MAY NOT REQUIRE THE**  
9 **HOMEOWNER TO PROVIDE THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF THE**  
10 **HOMEOWNER.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
12 June 1, 2009.
