# 1 (II) BE A MEMBER OF THE AIR FORCE CRITICAL SPECIALTY 2 CODE AS DETERMINED BY THE NATIONAL GUARD.

3 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, [beginning with the 4 2004 fall semester,] a spouse or financially dependent child of an active duty member 5 who enrolls as an entering student in a public institution of higher education and is 6 exempt from paying nonresident tuition under subsection (b) of this section shall 7 continue to be exempt from paying nonresident tuition if:
