- 25 (2) The required appropriation for fiscal year [2010] **2015** shall remain in effect for subsequent fiscal years unless altered by future enactment.
- 27 (b) (1) From the money appropriated for each of the fire companies in subsection (a) of this section:
- 29 (i) Except as provided in item (ii) of this paragraph, \$5,000 shall be placed into a capital account by the respective fire companies, and shall be used only for capital expenditures, such as purchasing, operating, and repairing fire apparatus and equipment; and
- 33 (ii) \$1,000 shall be placed into a capital account by the Tylerton 34 Volunteer Fire Company, and shall be used only for capital expenditures, such as 35 purchasing, operating, and repairing fire apparatus and equipment.
 - (2) Payments may not be made to any company which has any regulations or resolutions limiting the territory within which it will respond to calls.
 - (c) Each fire company receiving County funds shall provide an accounting of the expenditures of the funds to the County Commissioners.

- 1 (d) The County Commissioners may levy for and appropriate funds annually 2 for emergency services provided by any volunteer fire company or rescue squad if the 3 volunteer fire company or rescue squad is operated on a not for profit basis.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
