Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Winery License

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Harford County Liquor Control Board to issue a 4 Class W winery license to certain holders of a Class 4 manufacturer's license; 5 specifying the privileges conferred by the Class W winery license, including the 6 ability to sell wine and other products for consumption on or off the premises 7 and to maintain furnishings to enable patrons to consume wine and food; specifying that a Class W winery license is a 7-day license exempt from certain 8 9 quotas; providing a license fee; specifying the hours of sale for a Class W winery 10 license; making a certain stylistic change; providing that a holder of a certain 11 license may exchange that license for a Class W winery license under certain circumstances; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Harford County. 12

4 (D) FOR THE HOLDERS OF A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE, SALES ARE 5 ALLOWED:

6 (1) MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY FROM 10 A.M. THROUGH 1:45 7 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY; AND

8 (2) SUNDAY FROM 10 A.M. THROUGH MIDNIGHT, EXCEPT IF 9 CHRISTMAS EVE OR NEW YEAR'S EVE IS ON A SUNDAY, FROM 10 A.M. TO 2 A.M. 10 THE FOLLOWING DAY.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a holder of a Class 4 12 license who holds a Class A light wine license issued by the Harford County Liquor 13 Control Board may surrender the Class A license to the Board and, in exchange, be 14 issued a Class W winery license created by this Act at no charge. The expiration date 15 of a Class W winery license issued under this section shall be the same as the 16 expiration date of the surrendered Class A light wine license.

17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 July 1, 2009.
