- 22 **(C)** THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

2	BUILDINGS NEWLY CONSTRUCTED OR COMPLETELY RENOVATED AND OCCUPIED

4	PHYSICAL EDUCATION INSTRUCTION; AND
