## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning
Vehicle Laws - Bicycles, EPAMDs, and Motor Scooters - Rules of the Road
FOR the purpose of requiring a driver of a vehicle, when overtaking a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter, to pass safely at a certain distance; requiring a driver of a motor vehicle to yield the right-of-way to a person who is riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter in a designated bicycle lane; and generally relating to the rules of the road for bicycles, EPAMDs, and motor scooters.

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Transportation

21-1209.
(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the driver of a vehicle shall [exercise]:
(1) EXERCISE due care to avoid colliding with any bicycle, EPAMD, or motor scooter being ridden by a person; AND
(2) WHEN OVERTAKING A BICYCLE, AN EPAMD, OR A MOTOR SCOOTER, PASS SAFELY AT A DISTANCE OF NOT LESS THAN 3 FEET.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.
(b) A person may not throw any object at or in the direction of any person riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.
(c) A person may not open the door of any motor vehicle with intent to strike, injure, or interfere with any person riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.
(D) THE DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO A PERSON WHO IS RIDING A BICYCLE, AN EPAMD, OR A MOTOR SCOOTER IN A DESIGNATED BICYCLE LANE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
