BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - Transportation** 17 21-1209.18 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the driver of a vehicle 19 shall [exercise]:

3	(2) When overtaking a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor
4	SCOOTER, PASS SAFELY AT A DISTANCE OF NOT LESS THAN 3 FEET.
5	(b) A person may not throw any object at or in the direction of any person
6	riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.
7	(c) A person may not open the door of any motor vehicle with intent to strike,
8	injure, or interfere with any person riding a bicycle, an EPAMD, or a motor scooter.
9	(D) THE DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL YIELD THE
10	RIGHT-OF-WAY TO A PERSON WHO IS LAWFULLY RIDING A BICYCLE, AN
11	EPAMD, OR A MOTOR SCOOTER IN A DESIGNATED BICYCLE LANE OR
12	SHOULDER IF THE DRIVER IS ABOUT TO:
13	(1) MOVE THE MOTOR VEHICLE INTO OR ACROSS THE
14	DESIGNATED BICYCLE LANE OR SHOULDER;
15	(2) TURN INTO OR ACROSS THE DESIGNATED BICYCLE LANE OR
16	SHOULDER AT AN ALLEY, DRIVEWAY, OR PRIVATE ROAD; OR
17	(3) EXIT AN ALLEY, DRIVEWAY, OR PRIVATE ROAD INTO OR
18	ACROSS THE DESIGNATED BICYCLE LANE OR SHOULDER.
