- 2 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, on or after October 1, 3 [2009] **2012**, an individual shall be licensed by the Board before the individual may practice polysomnography in this State.
- 5 (b) This section does not apply to a student enrolled in an education program 6 under § 14–5C–09(c)(3) of this subtitle while practicing polysomnography in that 7 program.
- 8 14–5C–10.
- 9 (a) The Board shall waive the education requirement under § 14–5C–09(c)(3) 10 of this subtitle if on or before September 30, [2009] **2012**, an individual:
- 11 (1) Has passed the national certifying examination by the Board of Registered Polysomnographic Technologists;
- 13 (2) Is certified by the Board of Registered Polysomnographic 14 Technologists as a registered polysomnographic technologist;
- 15 (3) Has submitted an application for licensure to the Board; and
- 16 (4) Meets all of the requirements under § 14–5C–09(b) and (c)(1) and 17 (2) of this subtitle.
- 18 (b) (1) If an individual has not satisfied the requirements under 19 subsection (a) of this section on or before September 30, [2009] **2012**, the individual 20 may petition the Board for an extension.
- 21 (2) The Board shall determine whether to grant an extension under 22 this subsection on a case–by–case basis.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
