If an individual has not satisfied the requirements under 20(b) (1)21subsection (a) of this section on or before September 30, [2009] **2012** 2011, the 22individual may petition the Board for an extension. 23(2)The Board shall determine whether to grant an extension under 24this subsection on a case-by-case basis. 25SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26October 1, 2009.
