A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Yacht Club License**

3 FOR the purpose of altering certain requirements that a yacht club in Anne Arundel
4 County must meet to be issued a special Class C (yacht club) alcoholic beverages
5 license; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to alcoholic
6 beverages licenses in Anne Arundel County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

20 6–301.

21 (c) (1) This subsection applies only in Anne Arundel County.

22 (5) (i) There is a special Class C (yacht club) license.

23 (ii) The annual license fee is \$1,500.

1 (iii) Upon the approval of the Board, the license shall be issued
2 to any yacht club in the county:

3 1. Which has 50 or more bona fide members who pay
4 dues of not less than \$75 per year per member; and

5 2. Which maintains at the time of application for the
6 license:

7 A. [a] A clubhouse with a seating capacity sufficient to
8 accommodate at one time at least 100 persons[.];

9 B. [slips] **SLIPS, BOAT PARKING SPACES**, or berths for
10 [75] **AT LEAST 50** boats [or more]; and

11 C. [at] **AT** least [5 acres] **1 ACRE** of ground.

12 (iv) The licensee may keep for sale and sell at retail any
13 alcoholic beverages, to any member or guest when accompanied by a member at the
14 place described in the license. Consumption shall occur on the licensed premises only.
15 The licensee is subject to all of the provisions of this article relating to Class C beer,
16 wine and liquor licenses in Anne Arundel County.

17 (v) The application for the license filed on behalf of any yacht
18 club in the county shall be signed by at least one officer of the club, who shall be a
19 resident, registered voter and taxpayer of Anne Arundel County.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 July 1, 2009.
