## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## Prince George's County - Board of Education - Financial Literacy Curriculum Content

FOR the purpose of requiring the Prince George's County Board of Education to develop curriculum content for a certain course in financial literacy; requiring certain curriculum content to include certain instruction; requiring certain students to complete a certain course in order to graduate from high school; and generally relating to the development and implementation of a course in financial literacy.

Annotated Code of Maryland
(2008 Replacement Volume)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education
3-1008.
(A) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP CURRICULUM CONTENT FOR A SEMESTER-LONG COURSE IN FINANCIAL LITERACY.
(B) THE CURRICULUM CONTENT DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE INSTRUCTION REGARDING:
(1) CHOOSING A CAREER AND EARNING AN INCOME;

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.
(2) ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL DECISION MAKING;
(3) BASIC ECONOMIC CONCEPTS INCLUDING OPPORTUNITY COST, COST/BENEFIT ANALYSIS, AND SUPPLY AND DEMAND;
(4) SAVING AND INVESTING MONEY;
(5) CREDIT;
(6) CHARITABLE GIVING;
(7) HOUSEHOLD BUDGETING;
(8) INSURANCE;
(9) CONSUMER AWARENESS;
(10) UNDERSTANDING CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS; AND
(11) FRAUD AND IDENTITY THEFT.
(C) IN ORDER TO GRADUATE FROM HIGH SCHOOL IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, A STUDENT SHALL COMPLETE A COURSE IN FINANCIAL LITERACY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
