## Prince George's County - Board of Education - Financial Literacy Curriculum Content Pilot Program Course

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Prince George's County Board of Education to 5 develop and implement a certain pilot program that includes an elective course 6 on financial literacy as a part of the county board's high school curriculum; 7 requiring the county board to develop the curriculum content for a certain 8 course in financial literacy as a part of the pilot program; requiring certain 9 curriculum content to include certain instruction; requiring certain students to 10 complete a certain course in order to graduate from high school; requiring the county board to select a certain number of high schools in the county to 11 participate in the pilot program course; requiring the county board to submit a 12 13 certain report to the Prince George's County Senate Delegation and House Delegation on or before a certain date each year; providing for the termination 14 15 of this Act; and generally relating to the development and implementation of a 16 pilot program course in financial literacy.
