A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Environment – Noise Control Ordinances – Political Subdivisions

- FOR the purpose of requiring a political subdivision to adopt a noise control ordinance that is at least as stringent as certain standards, limits, and rules adopted by the Department of the Environment; requiring a political subdivision to consider compliance with certain standards before acting on certain variance requests or changes in zoning classifications, and prior to the issuance of certain permits or other authorizing documents; and generally relating to noise control ordinances.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
 - Article Environment
- 18 3–105.

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19 (a) (1) Except as provided in this section, this title does not limit the 20 power of a political subdivision to adopt noise control ordinances, rules, or regulations.

21 (2) A political subdivision [may not] SHALL adopt [any] A noise 22 control ordinance[, rule, or regulation] that is [less] AT LEAST AS stringent [than] AS 23 the environmental noise standards, sound level limits, and noise control rules and 24 regulations adopted under this title.

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1 (3) (i) A political subdivision may not adopt any noise control 2 ordinance, rule, or regulation, including the environmental noise standards, sound 3 level limits, and noise control rules and regulations adopted under this title, that 4 prohibits trapshooting, skeetshooting, or other target shooting between the hours of 9 5 a.m. and 10 p.m. by a shooting sports club that is chartered and in operation as of 6 January 1, 2001.

(ii) This paragraph does not apply in Allegany, Anne Arundel,
Baltimore City, Calvert, Charles, Garrett, Howard, Montgomery, St. Mary's, and
Washington counties.

10 (4)(i) Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, 11 Allegany County, Anne Arundel County, Garrett County, Washington County, or a political subdivision of Allegany County, Anne Arundel County, Garrett County, or 12 Washington County may not adopt any noise control ordinance, rule, or regulation, 13including the environmental noise standards, sound level limits, and noise control 14 15rules and regulations adopted under this title, that prohibits trapshooting, 16 skeetshooting, or other target shooting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. by a shooting sports club that is chartered and in operation as of January 1, 2005. 17

18 (ii) 1. Subject to the provisions of subsubparagraph 2 of this subparagraph, Allegany County, Anne Arundel County, Garrett County, Washington 19 20 County, or a political subdivision of Allegany County, Anne Arundel County, Garrett 21County, or Washington County may adopt any noise control ordinance, rule, or 22regulation, including the environmental noise standards, sound level limits, and noise 23control rules and regulations adopted under this title, that prohibits trapshooting, skeetshooting, or other target shooting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. by a 2425shooting sports club that the Department determines is not in compliance as of January 1, 2005 with environmental noise standards, sound level limits, or noise 2627control rules or regulations adopted under this title.

28 2. A noise control ordinance, rule, or regulation adopted 29 under subsubparagraph 1 of this subparagraph shall allow trapshooting, 30 skeetshooting, and other target shooting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. by a 31 shooting sports club that the Department determines has become compliant with 32 environmental noise standards, sound level limits, and noise control rules and 33 regulations adopted under this title.

(5) Carroll County or a political subdivision of Carroll County may not
enforce any noise control ordinance, rule, or regulation, including the environmental
noise standards, sound level limits, and noise control rules and regulations adopted
under this title, against a public school in Carroll County that violates the ordinance,
rule, or regulation between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9:30 p.m.

39 (b) Each political subdivision **SHALL**:

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1 (1) [Shall send] **SEND** to the Department a copy of each noise control 2 ordinance, rule, or regulation that it adopts;

3 (2) [Shall identify] **IDENTIFY** on each zoning map, comprehensive 4 plan, or other appropriate document the sound level limits that are adopted under 5 Subtitle 4 of this title; and

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- (3) [Is encouraged to consider] **CONSIDER**:

(i) Compliance with State or local noise standards before acting
 on any proposed variance requests or changes in zoning classifications; and

9 (ii) Whether the permit or activity will be in compliance with 10 local and State noise control standards, prior to the issuance of a building[,] activity 11 permit[,] or similar authorizing document.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 2009.
