- 1 (A) EACH YEAR THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL STATE OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS FUNDS FOR THE COMMISSION TO DISTRIBUTE TO HBIS AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.
- 4 (B) FUNDS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO 5 FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO THE HBIS IN THE STATE BUDGET IN THE PRIOR 6 FISCAL YEAR.
- 7 (C) FOR THE OPERATING BUDGET, THE AMOUNT OF THE DISTRIBUTION 8 FOR EACH HBI SHALL BE CALCULATED BY:
- 9 (1) INCREASING THE ANNUAL RECURRING STATE
  10 APPROPRIATION FOR EACH HBI BY NOT LESS THAN THE AVERAGE INCREASE IN

- 14 (2) MAINTAINING FISCAL YEAR 2010 ENHANCEMENT FUNDING OF 15 \$4,900,000 AND INCREASING THIS AMOUNT EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER BY 16 THE HIGHER EDUCATION PRICE INDEX;
- 17 (3) BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2010, PROVIDING A BASE OF \$500
  18 PER FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT STUDENT FOR FINANCIAL AID TO BE AWARDED BY
  19 THE HBI TO ELIGIBLE STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE INSTITUTION, AND
  20 INCREASING THIS AMOUNT EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER BY THE HIGHER
  21 EDUCATION PRICE INDEX; AND

15 (E) EXCEPT FOR CAPITAL FUNDING FOR MARYLAND INDEPENDENT
16 COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND MEDICAL
17 SYSTEM, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE
18 STATE SHALL PROVIDE HBIS 35% OF THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT RESOURCES
19 THAT ARE ALLOCATED TO INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION FOR CAPITAL
20 IMPROVEMENTS, WHETHER PROVIDED THROUGH THE CAPITAL BUDGET OR BY
21 PAY-AS-YOU-GO OPERATING FUNDING.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 July 1, 2009.
