- FOR the purpose of increasing certain fees for bingo conducted in Worcester County; increasing certain maximum prizes offered in bingo; repealing a prohibition against conducting bingo outside a certain area; specifying that a certain game may be played without a prize limit; repealing a prohibition against conducting bingo on Sunday; authorizing a person to advertise in a certain way the location and time of bingo and bingo prizes; and generally relating to bingo conducted in
