12 13 14 15	(IV) WICOMICO COUNTY MAY BY THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES ITS FINANCIAL REPORT COVERING THE FULL PERIOD OF THAT FISCAL YEAR.
