1 AN ACT concerning

Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages - Winery License

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Carroll County Board of License Commissioners to 4 issue a Class W winery license to certain holders of a Class 4 manufacturer's 5 license; specifying the privileges conferred by the Class W winery license. 6 including the ability to sell wine and other products for consumption on or off 7 the premises and to maintain furnishings to enable patrons to consume wine 8 and food; specifying that a Class W winery license is a 7-day license exempt 9 from certain quotas; providing a license fee; specifying the hours of sale for a 10 Class W winery license; making a certain stylistic change; providing that a 11 holder of a certain license may exchange that license for a Class W winery license under certain circumstances; and generally relating to alcoholic 12 beverages in Carroll County. 13

2 3	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
4	Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
5	SUBTITLE 3. CLASS W WINERY LICENSES.
6	4–301.
7	(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN CARROLL COUNTY.
8 9	(B) THE CARROLL COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE TO A LICENSEE WHO:
10	(1) HOLDS A CLASS 4 MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE; AND
11 12 13	(2) HAS BEEN A RESIDENT OF THE STATE FOR AT LEAST 2 YEARS IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE CLASS W WINERY LICENSE.
14 15	(C) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE SHALL BE SET BY THE BOARD BUT MAY NOT EXCEED \$200.
16	(D) A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO:
17 18	(1) PROVIDE SAMPLES OF WINE AND OTHER PRODUCTS PRODUCED BY THE LICENSEE AT NO CHARGE;
19 20	(2) SELL WINE AND OTHER PRODUCTS PRODUCED BY THE LICENSEE FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE PREMISES;
21 22	(3) HOLD PUBLIC AND PRIVATE EVENTS ON THE PREMISES IDENTIFIED IN THE LICENSE;
23 24	(4) SELL AND SERVE FOOD INCIDENTAL TO THE SAMPLING OF WINE; AND
25 26 27	(5) MAINTAIN TABLES, CHAIRS, AND OTHER APPROPRIATE INDOOR AND OUTDOOR FURNISHINGS TO ENABLE PATRONS TO CONSUME WINE AND FOOD.

28 (E) A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE IS A 7-DAY LICENSE.

- 1 (F) A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE IS EXEMPT FROM ANY QUOTA 2 ESTABLISHED AS TO THE NUMBER OF LICENSES IN THE ELECTION DISTRICT 3 WHERE THE CLASS W WINERY LICENSE IS TO BE LOCATED.
- 4 (G) A HOLDER OF A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE MAY LOCATE THE 5 OPERATION:
- 6 (1) ON THE PREMISES FOR WHICH THE CLASS 4 7 MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE WAS ISSUED;
- 8 (2) At the same address as another Class W winery 9 license; or
- 10 (3) AT ANOTHER LOCATION THAT THE LIQUOR BOARD 11 APPROVES.

- 13 (a) This section applies only in Carroll County.
- 14 (b) (1) [The] **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS** 15 **SECTION, THE** following restrictions, limitations, and regulations apply.
- 16 (C) FOR THE HOLDERS OF A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE, SALES ARE 17 ALLOWED:
- 18 (1) Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. through 1:45 19 a.m. the following day; and
- 20 (2) SUNDAY FROM 10 A.M. THROUGH MIDNIGHT, EXCEPT IF 21 CHRISTMAS EVE OR NEW YEAR'S EVE IS ON A SUNDAY, FROM 10 A.M. TO 2 A.M. 22 THE FOLLOWING DAY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a holder of a Class 4 license who holds a Class A light wine license issued by the Carroll County Board of License Commissioners may surrender the Class A license to the Board and, in exchange, be issued a Class W winery license created by this Act at no charge. The expiration date of a Class W winery license issued under this section shall be the same as the expiration date of the surrendered Class A light wine license.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2009.
