- 5 [(f)] (G) (1) (i) A Commissioner, FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME 6 inspector, or employee of the Board may not:
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- 10 2. Have any interest, directly or indirectly, in any business wholly or partially devoted to the manufacture or sale of alcoholic beverages; 12 or
- 3. Own any stock in any corporation which has any interest, proprietary or otherwise, directly or indirectly, in any premises where alcoholic beverages are manufactured or sold or in any business wholly or partially devoted to the manufacture or sale of alcoholic beverages, or hold any other public office or employment.
- 18 (ii) A Commissioner, **FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME** inspector, or 19 employee of the Board may not solicit or receive, directly or indirectly, any 20 commission, remuneration, or gift whatsoever from any person or corporation engaged 21 in the manufacture or sale of beer or other alcoholic beverages, from any licensee, 22 licensed under the provisions of this article.

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- (iii) A person or corporation engaged in the manufacture or sale of beer or other alcoholic beverages, any agent or employee of that person or corporation, and any licensee licensed under the provisions of this article may not, directly or indirectly, offer to pay any commission, profit, or remuneration or make any gift to any Commissioner, **FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME** inspector, or employee of the Board.
- 29 (2) Violations of this subsection are a misdemeanor punishable by a 30 fine of not more than \$1,000.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 32 June 1, 2009.
