6	(I) SUSPENSION FROM BIDDING AND WORKING ON STATE
7	CONTRACTS FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS; OR
8	(II) DEBARMENT FROM BIDDING OR PERFORMING ON STATE

10	(3) IN DETERMINING THE PENALTY TO BE IMPOSED UNDER
11	PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER:
12	(I) THE GOOD FAITH OF THE CONTRACTOR; AND
13	(II) ANY HISTORY OF PREVIOUS VIOLATIONS BY THE

15	(4) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS SHALL
16	MAKE AVAILABLE A FRAUD HOTLINE TO BE USED BY CERTIFIED MINORITY
17	BUSINESS ENTERPRISES TO REPORT A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION BY A
18	CONTRACTOR.
