A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Archery Hunting – Safety Zone**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing for archery hunters in Frederick County a safety
4 zone of a certain size within which archery hunting may not take place except
5 under certain circumstances; making a stylistic change; and generally relating
6 to archery hunting in Frederick County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Natural Resources**

15 10–410.

16 (g) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
17 SUBSECTION, A person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild
18 bird or mammal may not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon
19 within 150 yards, known as the “safety zone,” of a dwelling house, residence, church,
20 or other building or camp occupied by human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or
21 mammal while it is within this area, without the specific advance permission of the
22 owner or occupant.

23 (2) FOR ARCHERY HUNTERS IN FREDERICK COUNTY, THE
24 SAFETY ZONE DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION EXTENDS

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 **FOR 50 YARDS FROM A DWELLING HOUSE, RESIDENCE, CHURCH, OR OTHER**
2 **BUILDING OR CAMP OCCUPIED BY HUMAN BEINGS.**

3 **(3)** During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or
4 occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety
5 zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2009.
