17 (b) "Address" means [the post office address, and includes] A SINGLE 18 PHYSICAL LOCATION, INCLUDING A street and number, [if any,] county or 19 municipal area, and state and, if outside the United States, country, WHERE AN 20 ENTITY REGULARLY CONDUCTS BUSINESS AND AT WHICH THE ENTITY, OR AN 21 EMPLOYEE OF THE ENTITY, IS PHYSICALLY PRESENT.

1 (1) The [place] **ADDRESS** in this State filed or recorded with the 2 Department as the principal office of [a corporation or domestic limited partnership] 3 **AN ENTITY**; or

4 (2) If there is no principal office designated, the main office of the 5 [corporation or domestic limited partnership] **ENTITY** in this State for the transaction 6 of business.
