- 15 (h) (1) Except as provided in [paragraph (2)] **PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3)**16 of this subsection, all relief granted in a final protective order shall be effective for the
 17 period stated in the order, not to exceed [12 months] **1 YEAR**.
- 18 (2) If the court issues a final protective order under 19 This section against a respondent for an act of abuse committed 20 Within 1 year after the date that a prior protective order issued 21 Against the same respondent expires, all relief granted in the final 22 Protective order shall be effective for the period stated in the 23 Order, not to exceed 2 years.



SENATE BILL 811

- 1 (3) A subsequent circuit court order pertaining to any of the provisions included in the final protective order shall supersede those provisions in the final protective order.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2009.
