Property - Notice to Occupants

2	Real Property - Foreclosure of Mortgages and Deeds of Trust on Resident

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a certain notice to be sent to a certain address in a certain manner at the time of filing an action to foreclose a mortgage or deed of 5 6 trust on certain residential property; requiring a certain notice of foreclosure 7 sale to be sent to a certain address in a certain manner a certain period of time 8 before a foreclosure sale of certain property; requiring a certain notice to be sent 9 to a certain address in a certain manner after the entry of a judgment awarding 10 possession of certain property; requiring certain notices to be in a certain form 11 and contain certain information; requiring certain envelopes to contain a certain statement; defining a certain term; providing for the application of this Act; 12 making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to notices 13 14 regarding foreclosure actions on residential property.

- 3 **(E)** THE PERSON GIVING A NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL 4 FILE IN THE FORECLOSURE PROCEEDING AFTER EACH NOTICE IS SENT AN 5 AFFIDAVIT OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 6 IN THE EVENT OF POSTPONEMENT OF THE SALE, WHICH MAY BE **(F)** DONE IN THE DISCRETION OF THE PERSON AUTHORIZED TO MAKE THE SALE, NO NEW OR ADDITIONAL NOTICE NEED BE GIVEN PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have 10 11 any effect on or application to any foreclosure action filed before the effective date of 12 this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, 14 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members 15 16 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from 17 the date it is enacted.
