CHAPTER

1 AN ACT concerning

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## <u>Maryland Energy Administration</u> <u>Department of Labor, Licensing, and</u> <u>Regulation</u> – Green Jobs Workforce Training Program

FOR the purpose of establishing the Green Jobs Workforce Training Program; requiring the Maryland Energy Administration Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to administer the Program; requiring the Administration Department to consult regularly with the Governor's Workforce Investment Board Maryland Energy Administration, the Maryland Clean Energy Center, and the Department of Business and Economic Development concerning the activities of the Program; stating the purpose of the Program; authorizing the Administration Department to award a grant to a certain person or governmental unit; requiring the Administration Department to establish eligibility criteria for workforce training programs that may receive funding under this Act; establishing the Green Jobs Workforce Training Fund as a special, nonlapsing fund; providing for the purposes of the Fund; requiring the Administration Department to administer the Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to hold the Fund separately and the Comptroller to account for the Fund; providing for the contents of the Fund; providing for the use of the Fund; providing for the investment of money in the Fund; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Green Jobs Workforce Training Program.
