Commission to Study the Impact of Large Truck Traffic on the Chesapeake Bay Bridge

- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Commission to Study the Impact of Large Truck Traffic on the Chesapeake Bay Bridge; providing for the membership and 5 6 staffing of the Commission; requiring the Governor to designate the chair of the Commission; prohibiting members of the Commission from receiving certain 7 compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; 8 9 requiring the Commission to study certain matters and to report its findings 10 and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a 11 certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Commission to Study the Impact of Large Truck Traffic on the Chesapeake 12 Bay Bridge. 13
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That:
- 16 (a) There is a Commission to Study the Impact of Large Truck Traffic on the 17 Chesapeake Bay Bridge.
 - (b) The Commission consists of the following members:
- 19 (1) Two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the 20 President of the Senate;
- 21 (2) Two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker 22 of the House; and
- 23 (3) The following members appointed by the Governor:
- 24 (i) The Secretary of Transportation, or the Secretary's designee;
