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## St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Winery License

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the St. Mary's County Board of License 4 Commissioners to issue a Class W winery license to certain holders of a Class 4 5 manufacturer's license; specifying the privileges conferred by the Class W winery license, including the ability to sell wine and other products for 6 7 consumption on or off the premises and to maintain furnishings to enable 8 patrons to consume wine and food; specifying that a Class W winery license is a 9 7-day license exempt from certain quotas; providing a license fee; specifying the 10 hours of sale for a Class W winery license; making a certain stylistic change; 11 providing that a holder of a certain license may exchange that license for a Class W winery license under certain circumstances; and generally relating to 12 alcoholic beverages in St. Mary's County. 13

3	(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY.
4	(B) THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS

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- 9 (A) In St. Mary's County, **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION** (B) OF THIS SECTION, BUT notwithstanding any other provision of this article, the hours during which a liquor licensee may sell those alcoholic beverages for which he is licensed shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. the following morning, including Sunday. No consumer may remain on the premises of the establishment after the termination of the hours of sale, except that customers may remain on the premises for one-half hour after the closing time on Sunday morning.
- 16 (B) IN ST. MARY'S COUNTY, FOR THE HOLDERS OF A CLASS W WINERY LICENSE, SALES ARE ALLOWED:
- 18 (1) Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. through 1:45 19 a.m. the following day; and
- 20 (2) SUNDAY FROM 10 A.M. THROUGH MIDNIGHT, EXCEPT IF 21 CHRISTMAS EVE OR NEW YEAR'S EVE IS ON A SUNDAY, FROM 10 A.M. TO 2 A.M. 22 THE FOLLOWING DAY.
  - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a holder of a Class 4 manufacturer's license who holds a Class A light wine license issued by the St. Mary's County Board of License Commissioners may surrender the Class A light wine license to the Board and, in exchange, be issued a Class W winery license created by this Act at no charge. The expiration date of a Class W winery license issued under this section shall be the same as the expiration date of the surrendered Class A light wine license.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 July 1, 2009.
