AN ACT concerning
State Government - Commemorative Days - Firemen and Rescue Workers Memorial Service
FOR the purpose of requiring the memorial service commemorating firemen and other rescue workers that is organized by a certain organization to be held annually on a certain date at a certain place; and generally relating to the firemen and rescue workers memorial service.
BY adding to Article – State Government Section 13–408 Annotated Code of Maryland (2004 Replacement Volume and 2008 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - State Government
13–408.
THE MEMORIAL SERVICE COMMEMORATING FIREMEN AND RESCUE WORKERS THAT IS ORGANIZED BY THE MARYLAND FIRE-RESCUE SERVICES MEMORIAL FOUNDATION, INC. SHALL BE HELD ANNUALLY ON THE FIRST SUNDAY IN JUNE AT THE MARYLAND FIRE-RESCUE SERVICES MEMORIAL IN THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS.
