### Baltimore City Charter - East Baltimore Community Benefits District

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to establish 4 by ordinance the East Baltimore Community Benefits District to provide certain 5 services; authorizing the Mayor and City Council to establish the East 6 Baltimore Community Benefits District Authority to provide certain services; 7 requiring a certain ordinance to provide the method for establishing certain 8 boundaries; requiring a certain ordinance to specify certain taxes; providing for 9 the appointment of officers and board members of the East Baltimore 10 Community Benefits District; requiring a certain financial plan to be subject to approval by the Baltimore City Board of Estimates; providing certain 11 12 limitations, powers, and duties of the East Baltimore Community Benefits 13 District Authority; requiring the Mayor and City Council to take certain matters into consideration when enacting certain ordinances; prohibiting the 14 15 Mayor and City Council from authorizing certain reductions in services; 16 providing for the reversion of unspent funds under a certain condition; placing a certain condition on a certain ordinance taking effect; and generally relating to 17 18 the establishment of the East Baltimore Community Benefits District.
