1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article - Education**

4 24-601.

5 (a) There is a Commission on Civic Literacy.

6 (b) The Commission consists of the following members:

7 (27) Two students enrolled in public high schools in Maryland,
8 appointed by the Maryland Association of Student Councils; [and]

9 (28) Two teachers who teach in public high schools in Maryland,
10 appointed by the Maryland State Teachers Association; **AND**

11 **(29) ONE MEMBER OF THE JUDICIARY OF THE STATE, APPOINTED**
12 **BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS.**

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2009.
