12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Natural Resources

16 (A) (1) A CRAB POT SET BY A PERSON TO CATCH CRABS SHALL BE 17 MARKED BY A BUOY THAT IS:

- 18 (I) EASILY VISIBLE ON THE SURFACE OF THE WATER BY
 19 VIRTUE OF ITS SIZE AND COLOR; AND
- 20(II) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS21SUBSECTION, CONSTRUCTED OF DURABLE MATERIAL.

1 (2) A BUOY MARKING A CRAB POT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF 2 THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUCTED OF A GLASS OR PLASTIC BOTTLE, 3 JUG, OR METAL CAN.

4 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT 5 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2009.
