5 United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency’s 287(g)
6 Delegation of Authority program; and generally relating to the United States

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Public Safety**

22 2–101.

23 (g) (1) “Law enforcement agency” means a law enforcement agency of a
24 department, county, or municipal corporation of the State.

6 **2-101 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

7 (B) **A STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT RECEIVES STATE**
8 **FUNDS SHALL ENROLL IN THE UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS**
9 **ENFORCEMENT AGENCY’S 287(G) DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY PROGRAM**
10 **UNDER § 287(G) OF THE IMMIGRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2009.
