Environment - Incinerator Permits - Limitation on Issuance near National Parks

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Department of the Environment from issuing a
permit to a person to construct, modify, operate, or use an incinerator in the
State if the incinerator is or would be located within a certain distance of a park
in the National Park System; and generally relating to the authority of the
Department of the Environment to issue a permit to construct, modify, operate,
or use an incinerator in the State.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Environment

18 2-401.

(A) Except as provided in § 2–402 of this subtitle, the Department may adopt
 regulations that require a permit or registration before a person constructs, modifies,
 operates, or uses a source that may cause or control emissions into the air.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY NOT ISSUE A PERMIT TO A PERSON TO
 CONSTRUCT, MODIFY, OPERATE, OR USE AN INCINERATOR IN THE STATE IF THE
 INCINERATOR IS OR WOULD BE LOCATED WITHIN 1 MILE OF A PARK IN THE
 NATIONAL PARK SYSTEM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
