24 25	(a) The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section.



- 1 (b) "Authority" means the Baltimore County Revenue Authority created by 2 this article.
- 3 (l) "Project" means any structure, facility, or undertaking or any combination thereof of a similar class or character which the authority is authorized to construct, improve, equip, furnish, maintain, acquire, or operate under the provisions of this article.

- 8 (A) BEFORE CLOSING, SELLING, TRANSFERRING, OR CONVEYING ANY 9 FACILITY OR PROJECT OPERATED BY THE AUTHORITY, THE AUTHORITY SHALL 10 HOLD AT LEAST TWO PUBLIC HEARINGS.
- 11 (B) THE FIRST PUBLIC HEARING SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST ONE MONTH 12 BEFORE THE SECOND PUBLIC HEARING.
- 13 (C) THE SECOND PUBLIC HEARING SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST ONE 14 MONTH BEFORE THE DATE THAT THE FACILITY OR PROJECT WILL BE CLOSED, 15 SOLD, TRANSFERRED, OR CONVEYED.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
