## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County Revenue Authority – Closure, Sale, Transfer, or**  
3 **Conveyance of Facility or Project**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore County Revenue Authority to hold a  
5 certain number of public hearings before closing, selling, transferring, or  
6 conveying a certain facility or project; requiring that the public hearings be held  
7 at certain intervals; requiring that a certain public hearing be held a certain  
8 amount of time before a certain facility or project is closed, sold, transferred, or  
9 conveyed; and generally relating to the Baltimore County Revenue Authority.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
11 The Public Local Laws of Baltimore County  
12 Section 9–1–101(a), (b), and (l)  
13 Article 3 – Public Local Laws of Maryland  
14 (2003 Edition and January 2009 Supplement, as amended)

15 BY adding to  
16 The Public Local Laws of Baltimore County  
17 Section 9–1–104.1  
18 Article 3 – Public Local Laws of Maryland  
19 (2003 Edition and January 2009 Supplement, as amended)

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article 3 – Baltimore County**

23 9–1–101.

24 (a) The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this article, shall  
25 have the meanings ascribed to them in this section.

1 (b) "Authority" means the Baltimore County Revenue Authority created by  
2 this article.

3 (l) "Project" means any structure, facility, or undertaking or any  
4 combination thereof of a similar class or character which the authority is authorized to  
5 construct, improve, equip, furnish, maintain, acquire, or operate under the provisions  
6 of this article.

7 **9-1-104.1.**

8 (A) **BEFORE CLOSING, SELLING, TRANSFERRING, OR CONVEYING ANY**  
9 **FACILITY OR PROJECT OPERATED BY THE AUTHORITY, THE AUTHORITY SHALL**  
10 **HOLD AT LEAST TWO PUBLIC HEARINGS.**

11 (B) **THE FIRST PUBLIC HEARING SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST ONE MONTH**  
12 **BEFORE THE SECOND PUBLIC HEARING.**

13 (C) **THE SECOND PUBLIC HEARING SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST ONE**  
14 **MONTH BEFORE THE DATE THAT THE FACILITY OR PROJECT WILL BE CLOSED,**  
15 **SOLD, TRANSFERRED, OR CONVEYED.**

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
17 October 1, 2009.
