4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore County Revenue Authority to hold a

6 or conveying a certain facility or project; ~~requiring that the public hearings be~~
7 ~~held at certain intervals~~; requiring that a certain public hearing be held a
8 certain amount of time before a certain facility or project is closed, sold,
9 transferred, or conveyed; and generally relating to the Baltimore County
10 Revenue Authority.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article 3 – Baltimore County**

2 9–1–101.

3 (a) The following words, terms, and phrases, when used in this article, shall
4 have the meanings ascribed to them in this section.

5 (b) “Authority” means the Baltimore County Revenue Authority created by
6 this article.

7 (l) “Project” means any structure, facility, or undertaking or any
8 combination thereof of a similar class or character which the authority is authorized to
9 construct, improve, equip, furnish, maintain, acquire, or operate under the provisions
10 of this article.

11 **9–1–104.1.**

12 **(A) BEFORE CLOSING, SELLING, TRANSFERRING, OR CONVEYING ANY**
13 **FACILITY OR PROJECT OPERATED BY THE AUTHORITY, THE AUTHORITY SHALL**
14 **HOLD AT LEAST TWO A PUBLIC HEARINGS HEARING.**

15 **(B) ~~THE FIRST PUBLIC HEARING SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST ONE MONTH~~**
16 **~~BEFORE THE SECOND PUBLIC HEARING.~~**

17 **(C) ~~THE SECOND~~ PUBLIC HEARING SHALL BE HELD AT LEAST ONE**
18 **MONTH BEFORE THE DATE THAT THE FACILITY OR PROJECT WILL BE CLOSED,**
19 **SOLD, TRANSFERRED, OR CONVEYED.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2009.
