13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A HEALTH
18 OCCUPATIONS BOARD MAY FILL A VACANT CONTRACTUAL OR PERMANENT
19 STAFF POSITION WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY HIRING FREEZE APPLICABLE TO
20 THE POSITION IF:

(1) THE BOARD DETERMINES THAT FILLING THE POSITION IS
NECESSARY TO ENABLE THE BOARD TO COMPLY WITH A DUTY IMPOSED ON THE
BOARD BY STATUTE OR REGULATION; AND



# 1 (2) THE COST OF THE POSITION, INCLUDING ANY FRINGE 2 BENEFITS, IS FUNDED FROM FUNDS OF THE BOARD.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 4 July 1, 2009.
