2 Cigarette Business Licenses - Cigarette Manufacturers - Definitions and 3 Scope of License

4 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "manufacturer" in connection with the licensing of cigarette businesses and certain cigarette safety standards to 5 6 include certain persons who operate cigarette manufacturing plants outside the 7 United States and certain participating manufacturers; providing that a 8 cigarette manufacturer license authorizes the licensee to sell certain unstamped 9 cigarettes to certain cigarette wholesalers located outside of Maryland under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; and generally relating to 10 cigarette manufacturers and the licensing of cigarette businesses. 11
