BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 5 Article – Election Law 6 7 Section 8–201 8 Annotated Code of Maryland (2003 Volume and 2008 Supplement) 9 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 11 12 **Article - Election Law** 13 8-201.14 (a) (1) There shall be a statewide primary election in every even-numbered year. 15 16 (2)A primary election shall be held: in the year in which the Governor is elected, on the second 17 (i) 18 Tuesday after the first Monday in [September] JUNE; and 19 in the year in which the President of the United States is (ii) elected, on the second Tuesday in February. 20



- 1 (b) In Baltimore City, there shall be a primary election for municipal offices 2 on the second Tuesday following the first Monday in September in the year following 3 the election of the Governor.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2009.
