A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law – Gubernatorial Primary Election – Date**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the date for the primary election in the year of the
4 gubernatorial election; and generally relating to the date for primary elections.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article – Election Law**

13 8–201.

14 (a) (1) There shall be a statewide primary election in every
15 even-numbered year.

16 (2) A primary election shall be held:

17 (i) in the year in which the Governor is elected, on the second
18 Tuesday after the first Monday in [September] **JUNE**; and

19 (ii) in the year in which the President of the United States is
20 elected, on the second Tuesday in February.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 (b) In Baltimore City, there shall be a primary election for municipal offices
2 on the second Tuesday following the first Monday in September in the year following
3 the election of the Governor.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2009.
