

CHAPTER 667

(House Bill 348)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County – Board of Education – Student Member Scholarship

FOR the purpose of establishing a certain scholarship for the student member of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education who fulfills a certain requirement; providing that this Act does not apply to the incumbent student board member; and generally relating to the Anne Arundel County Board of Education.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

3–110.

(g) (1) The President of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education is entitled to receive \$8,000 annually as compensation and, except for the student member, the other board members are entitled to receive \$6,000 each annually as compensation.

(2) **A STUDENT MEMBER WHO COMPLETES A FULL TERM ON THE BOARD SHALL BE GRANTED A SCHOLARSHIP OF ~~\$5,000~~ \$6,000 TO BE APPLIED TOWARD THE STUDENT’S HIGHER EDUCATION COSTS.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the current student member of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning a scholarship for the student member of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2009.
